



ADMISSIONS POLICY Proposal Changes 2019

One In A Million Free School is consulting on the following proposed changes to its Admissions Policy from September 2019.

Amendment of existing criteria

We are proposing to amend the ruling regarding twins and triplets, which is already within the Policy, to extend it to include brothers and sisters born within the same admission year, alongside those from multiple births.

We are also making an amendment to the allocation of places if the Oversubscription Criteria comes into play.

The allocation of sibling places, children with a sibling attending the school at the time of application, will have the priority claim on places, however, the number of places available will be restricted to meet the geographical split.

Consultation period and comments

The consultation lasts until Friday 26th January 2018 and we invite comments both from existing parents and other interested parties.
